Contract W-7405 eng-4.

Reference is made to your letter EIDM A-33 MS of August 27th, 1945.

Contract W-7405 eng-4 called for the delivery of 100 T of M-31, the M308 content of which was sold to you, whereas we reserved all rights to the R-1 contained therein.

We hereby certify that the liability of the ^{My} Gouvernement in connection with the M308 contained has been completely fulfilled, and that the R-1 contained has been returned to us in accordance with separate contract entered into between this Corporation and the Eldorado Mining and Refining Company, Port Hope.

We also certify that the provisions of Article III as amended of the contract which state that except for the precious metals recoverable in the M-31, 50% of the R-1 shall be returned to the United States, and 50% shall remain in Canada for export to Great Britain and/or its Dominions have been complied with.
