

SPECIAL NUCLEAR MATERIAL LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 70, "Special Nuclear Material Regulations," a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive and possess the special nuclear material designated below; to use such special nuclear material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; and to transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations in said Part. This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 70.32(a) of said regulations, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Atomic Energy Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

10. Unless otherwise specified, the authorized place of use is the licensee's address stated in Item 2 above. **Authorized place of use, 11177 East Eight Mile Road, Warren Township, Michigan.**

Except as hereinafter provided the licensee shall comply with provisions of the Atomic Energy Commission's proposed standards for protection against radiation as published in the Federal Register July 16, 1955 (10 CFR 20), until such time as said proposed regulations or revisions thereof become effective regulations of the Commission. Notwithstanding Section 20.24(f) of said standards, labeling shall not be required for laboratory containers such as beakers, flasks and test tubes, used transiently in laboratory procedures during the use.
