Dear Sirs:

We hereby license the University of Chicago to use our Micronizer Reduction Mill, serial #188, experimentally for a period of six months, beginning as of November 22, 1943, for a consideration of \$1. At the end of said experimental period, we shall be willing to extend the same, should you desire to continue the use of this equipment, upon terms which shall be mutually satisfactory. Otherwise, the mill will be returned to our company in its then condition, without further obligation on the part of your Institution.

It is our understanding that the mill will be used experimentally only and that, because of the type of work you are undertaking, the nature of the material cannot be revealed to us at this time. This work is being carried on for the United States government.

All inventions and improvements of a patentable nature in reference to the mill, which may be made at your Institution, shall be assigned to our company, both as to the United States and any foreign country where our company may desire any patent protection, provided, however, that the costs in connection with the preparation, filing and prosecution of the same shall be entirely at the expense of our company. This provision, however, is subject to any prior arrangement between your Institution and the government with respect to inventions and patents.

It is also the understanding that your Institution will carry such insurance as you may deem advisable in connection with this mill or its use while at the University.





