The Department of Energy (DOE), as part of its Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP), has reviewed information on the former site of the Virginia-Carolina Chemical Corporation, located at 818 Perry Street in Richmond, Virginia, to determine whether it contains residual radioactivity traceable to activities conducted on behalf of the Manhattan Engineer District and the Atomic Energy Commission (predecessors to DOE). Based on this review, DOE has concluded that there are no quantities of radioactive material above current guidelines remaining at the site. Therefore, no remedial action is required, and DOE is eliminating the site from further consideration under FUSRAP.

The information supporting this decision will be archived by DOE, and a copy of the elimination report will be available for public review between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (except Federal holidays), at the DOE Public Document Room located in Room 1E-190 of the Forrestal Building, 1000 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C.
