This is in confirmation of a telephone conversation on November 19 between B. M. Robinson and A. H. Noto concerning the above subject.

Simonds has agreed to roll approximately 8500 pounds of thorium ingots on November 24 or November 25, 1952. Approximately 3.3 tons of thorium ingots are for the balance of ORNL's requirement of slugs for their dissolution study program. The remaining ingots will be used for the irradiation program at Hanford.

We understand that National Lead Company will handle this rolling as they did in the previous thorium rollings performed at Simonds.

Arrangements for the transfer of the ingots from our Lake Ontario Storage Area to Simonds have been made by this office.
