Subject: HOT TENSILE TESTS OF URANIUM - SOUTHERN RESEARCH INSTITUTE

Dear Mr. Noyes:

Reference is made to your letter of May 17, 1962, on the above subject.

Approval is granted for the off-site movement of up to 300 pounds of normal uranium by the National Lead Company of Ohio to the Southern Research Institute, Birmingham, Alabama for testing purposes.

Accountability for the material should be retained in SS Station NLO's records during the testing period. The Monthly Material Balance Reports for normal uranium submitted by NLO should include as a separate item, under composition of ending inventory, the quantity located at the Southern Research Institute. Also, any other normal uranium located off-site for which an SS station has not been established should be reported in the same manner.

The purchase order for these services should contain appropriate conditions whereby the vendor will comply with the health and safety practices as prescribed by Parts 20, 40, and 70 of the Code of Federal Regulations in performing these tests.

Please advise if we can be of further assistance in this matter.
