Subject: RETURN OF SCRAP MATERIAL

Gentlemen:

In accordance with conversations between our Mr. G. E. Dunlap and your Mr. D. B. Metz, please return to recast the following scrap material from Hicksville:

- 1. 5,750 lbs. of Fernald reject slugs.
- 2. 10,000 lbs. rejected powder metallurgy slugs.
- 3. 5,345 lbs. uranium scrap and sludge\*.

\*This material, we understand, has already been shipped and this confirms authorization to do so.

Further, in accord with the conversation with Mr. Metz we are cancelling your order for 10 tons of ingot material which you requested in your letter to the Commission dated April 29 and replacing it with 8 tons of uranium which will be divided as follows:

- Four tons standard uranium ingot
- Four tons standard uncropped derbies.

The request for derby metal is in accordance with the recommendations of Sylvania Electric Products, Inc. to the effect that uranium derby metal is a suitable material for producing slugs for evaluation at Hanford Works. We would like to make the point that this is your request and that you fully realize the background on this question. Hanford has expressed a desire for material having a minimum of 250 ppm of carbon.
