SUMMARY

The Utica Street Warehouse stored and rebarrelled residue from Linde operations. The warehouse was demolished at an unknown time. The property has been used as a paved parking lot and presently is the site of the entrance drive to a parking garage. Because the facilities were only used for storage-related operations and have been demolished, no RUSRAP action is required. It is therefore recommended that this site be eliminated.

Dear Mr. Murphy:

This is in reply to your letter of March 12th concerning Fire and Extended Coverage for Chandler Project material to be stored at the West Utica Street Warehouse. As you know, this warehouse was leased for storing Ceramics Plant materials and is not at present insured since insurance is not required for government owned materials under fixed-fee contract. We understand that the Chandler Plant will also be operated under fixed-fee contract and when this contract is executed, it will probably be unnecessary to provide such coverage. Until then, it is presumably the company's responsibility to see that project materials are protected by insurance.

We agree with the insurance agent's opinion that the physical condition of the Utica Street Building will probably call for a high rate. However, we do not expect to store Chandler Project materials in this building beyond 30 days from this date. As you know, we have negotiated for the lease of a warehouse building on Southwest Genesee Street that will provide adequate storage space for all Chandler Plant materials to be stored outside the plant. This building is of brick and wood construction and is sprinklered throughout and therefore should not demand a very high rate. Our tenancy of this building begins on April 1st on a sublease from the Bell Aircraft Corporation. The following May 1st, we will have a primary lease from the owners. Agreement forms for these leases have been sent to your office for approval. Since we expect to move the Chandler Project materials from the Utica Street Warehouse to the Genesee Street Building in early April, it does not seem advisable to provide coverage for this short period. We estimate the peak value of material to be stored at Utica Street to be approximately \$100,000.00 and they would be subject to total loss in the event the building burned down.
