Dear Sir:

Under the Uranium Mill Tailings Radiation Control Act of 1978, Public Law 95-604, the Department of Energy (DOE) is authorized to conduct remedial action at properties contaminated with residual radioactive material from inactive uranium mill sites.

Evaluation of your property identified above has revealed the presence of residual radioactive material in excess of standards established by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Therefore, your property has been formally included by DOE for remedial action in the Uranium Mill Tailings Remedial Action Project. The objective of the remedial action is to reduce radiation levels to below EPA standards. Generally, this will be done by removing the residual radioactive material from the property. It is DOE policy to restore the property to as near its original condition as possible. The remedial action will be done at no expense to you.

In the future, representatives of Morrison Knudsen-Ferguson Co., Inc., contractor to the DOE, will be contacting you to discuss planning of future activities including detailed data gathering, engineering, and remedial action construction. They will be able to provide information on the general location of tailings on your property. Although we cannot, at this time, give you specific schedules for future activities, John Pepin of Morrison Knudsen-Ferguson Co., may be contacted at (505) 766-3076 to provide a general idea of when additional work will be performed.
