PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING ON
WELDON SPRING SITE REMEDIAL ACTION PROJECT

WELDON SPRING, MISSOURI -- The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced late Thursday that they will jointly sponsor a meeting to update community residents on the progress at the Weldon Spring Site Remedial Action Project (WSSRAP).

The public meeting will be held on Thursday, February 25, 1988, at 7:30 p.m. at the Francis Howell High School Gymnasium. All interested citizens are invited to attend.

Topics to be discussed include a briefing on the recent EPA request that DOE prepare an environmental analysis of the project to be issued as a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) which will also include Environmental Impact Statement requirements.

Additional topics for discussion include an update on nine Interim Response Actions (IRAs), water quality study results, and quarry and wellfield monitoring.
