Plans For Weldon Spring Cleanup Made Available For Review

Plans for four environmental cleanup operations in the Weldon Spring area are available for review throughout St. Charles County, the U.S. Department of Energy has announced.

The four work plans are for removal of a transformer containing PCB, debris consolidation, dismantling of building 401 — the steam plant — and dismantling of building 409 — the administration building. All of the plans have to do with interim cleanup of a former uranium processing plant on Highway 94 near Weldon Spring.

The plans are part of a \$357 million cleanup operation that the Department of Energy began last July.

The four locations where the plans can be reviewed are:

- The Spencer Road Branch of the St. Charles City-County Library District, 425 Spencer Road, St. Peters;
- Butler Library on the campus of Lindenwood College, Kingshighway at First Capitol Drive, St. Charles;
- The Francis Howell High School Library, 7001 Highway 94 South; and
- The Weldon Spring work site on Highway 94.
