

WELDON SPRING, MO -- The U.S. Department of Energy announced today a public meeting to be co-sponsored with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Members of the various state agencies providing regulatory overview of the project will also be in attendance.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 6, at 7:30 p.m. at Young Auditorium at Lindenwood College in St. Charles.

Topics to be presented will include the recently released environmental compliance work plan. The work plan lays out the activities and processes which must be carried out in order to reach site cleanup decisions. Another topic to be presented will be a status report on site Interim Response Actions or IRAs. IRAs are those activities that are undertaken to improve environmental conditions at the site.

Presentations will be short and will be followed by a question and answer period.
