During the technical information exchange meeting on September 26, we discussed the pumping of contaminated water under Plant 6. It was stated that wells are installed and awaiting the completion of the EE/CA on this removal action. It is Ohio EPA's position that these new recovery wells should begin pumping as soon as possible. The intent of the removal action is to provide an environmental benefit by removing contaminated perched water and removing a potential source of ground water contamination. Actual removal of contaminated water from under Plant 6 (clarifier pit) began in August, 1988. EE/CA preparation can continue, but there is no need to wait until January 1990 to begin pumping these new wells. If you have any questions, please contact me.
