Town Meeting


A discussion of accomplishments and future plans at the Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC) will be held for interested Fernald area residents on Tuesday, March 15, at 7:30 p.m. at Stricker's Grove.

The FMPC is a uranium metals production plant operated by Westinghouse Materials Company of Ohio under contract with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE).

Westinghouse and DOE officials will report on the progress made in addressing the environmental, safety and health concerns and additional improvements under way at the facility. Fernald Area residents also will have an opportunity to question senior plant officials about changes taking place at the FMPC.
