The U. S. Department of Energy is hosting its third community meeting of the year on Tuesday evening, October 24, at Stricker's Grove on State Route 128. The purpose of this meeting is to inform the community of the progress the Feed Materials Production Center is making on the environmental cleanup of the site and to receive your input on this activity.

The current thrust of the cleanup, now in the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility (RI/FS) phase, is intended to define the types and extent of contamination on the FMPC site. Preceding the formal presentation at the upcoming meeting, an informal session, will be held to provide you with an opportunity to ask questions and voice concerns about the RI/FS. Technical experts on ground water, near- and long term cleanup, and other areas will be available to meet with you individually during this session, which will begin at 6:00 p.m.

From 7:30 - 9:30 p.m. formal talks will be presented concerning RI/FS activities, followed by a questions and answers session with representatives of DOE and its contractors, and the Ohio and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Technical experts will remain after this session to answer any additional questions you may have concerning these activities.

This meeting is one of continuing series of community meetings focusing on the FMPC environmental cleanup.


