# PUBLIC MEETING

- The U.S. Department of Energy is conducting an environmental study at the Feed Materials Production Center, called the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS), to determine the extent of any environmental problems and develop alternatives for addressing these issues.
- Sharing information with you is vitally important.
- A meeting will be held Tuesday, January 31, at 7 p.m. at the Ross Middle School. (In the event of a snow emergency, the meeting will be rescheduled on Tuesday, February 7.)
- The meeting will include: brief comments from the DOE and its contractors, then will break into small groups focusing on specific elements of the RI/FS. The classroom discussions will address topics such as surface soils and biology, groundwater, regulation and restoration.
- Scientists and engineers from Advanced Sciences, Inc. will be available to answer questions.
- Representatives from U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA will participate in the evening's agenda.
- While we expect the sessions to last about an hour to an hour and a half, our people will remain available until everyone's questions and comments have been received and noted.
