Fernald plaintiffs fight legal move

CINCINNATI — Lawyers for 14,000 Fernald-area residents Thursday filed a motion in U.S. District Court here opposing efforts by the U.S. Energy Department to quash more than a dozen statements supporting a lawsuit against the former operator of the Feed Materials Production Center. Residents are suing National Lead of Ohio, which operated the uranium processing plant from 1951 to 1986. They contend the plant has damaged their mental health and lowered area property values. The suit filed in 1985 moves to a seven-day summary jury trial, beginning on Monday. The non-binding trial is an attempt by the judge to promote a settlement and avoid an expected lengthy trial scheduled for mid-August. Energy Department lawyers last week asked federal Judge S. Arthur Spiegel to eliminate the statements of 14 people. They charge that surprise witnesses had been added.
