The referenced letter transmitted the Work Plans for the Plant 9 and the Plant 2/3 Removal Actions on May 4, 1990. According to the Consent Agreement, Section IX.C., U.S. EPA shall provide written comments to DOE within 30 days of receipt of any Work Plan or EE/CA document submitted pursuant to the Agreement (June 6, 1990).

To date, no comments have been received from U.S. EPA on the Plant 9 or Plant 2/3 Work Plans. DOE is presently working to ensure that the Work Plans address Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) and are consistent with the recently revised Plant 6 Work Plan (Reference 2). Any U.S. EPA comments received will also be addressed in the revised Work Plans.
