Due to recent developments during the Plant 6 construction project, it has become evident for the need to incorporate all construction sampling results into the Remedial Investigation (RI) for the U.S. Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Feed Material Production Center. The Plant 6 soil sampling indicated that over 13,000 ppm of total uranium is present in the underlying soils.

All analytical results from construction or any other project at the facility should be accumulated and integrated into the RI data base. U.S. DOE should be prepared to discuss the data's historic management, the extent of this data, and its integration into the RI at the September 20, 1988, monthly technical meeting.
