Dear Mr. Winston:

During our July 22, 1987 meeting at the FMPC on the RI/FS, we agreed to provide your office with the following reports:

1. Exhibit B dated November 14, 1986, with the subject "Final Interim Report - Air, Soil, Water and Health Risk Assessment in the Vicinity of the FMPC - Fernald, Ohio."
2. Data package from sampling performed by IT Corporation in support of DOE litigation.
3. FMPC - 2082 "History of FMPC Radionuclide Discharges" dated May 1987.

Reports 1 and 2 above provide (1) data and information regarding off-site impacts from the FMPC, and (2) an assessment of the associated risks to the local community. These reports, to be integrated with the Characterization Investigation Study (CIS) and the Site Wide RI/FS, will form a substantial data base for the off-site phase of the RI/FS.

Report 3 above was prepared to support Task 3.f. (Air Investigation) of the RI/FS in which DOE is to determine the extent of atmospheric contamination associated with past FMPC operations. The IT Corporation is performing this work for DOE with the support, guidance and assistance of the Centers for Disease Control, USEPA, and the Ohio Division of Epidemiology.

At the July 22 meeting, we offered to provide your office with a detailed briefing on both of these efforts associated with the

RI/FS (off-site sampling/risk assessment and historical dose assessment). The date of August 4, 1987 was discussed as being a near-term possibility. Please confirm with Rick Collier (513-738-6660 or FTS 774-6660) the suitability of this date and the proposed location as soon as possible.
