**FMPC EXCAVATION AND DEMOLITION ACTIVITIES**

The purpose of this letter is to respond to the referenced letter concerning construction operation and disturbances of soils in contaminated areas at the Feed Materials Production Center (FMPC).

To address this and other pending CERCLA issues, DOE has formed a CERCLA working group to review all FMPC activities to assure compliance with 1) 40 CFR 300, the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP), 2) the Federal Facilities Consent Agreement, and 3) the requirements and schedules of any similar agreements with Ohio EPA.

The group has formulated a plan to address any potential releases of hazardous substances into the environment as a result of excavation and demolition activities at the FMPC in a manner consistent with the revised NCP. This plan will address the issues outlined in the referenced letter, which deal with disturbance of soils at the site.

My staff plans to review this plan with you at a scheduled meeting on April 6, 1990 in Chicago. In the meantime the FMPC will execute all excavation activities at the site in accordance with the intent of the plan which has been developed.
