

**REMOVAL ACTION MEMORANDUM: K-65 DECANT SUMP TANK**

Reference: Letter, WMCO:EMT:90-539, J.P. Hopper to G. W. Westerbeck, "Removal Site Evaluation for K-65 Decant Sump Tank", dated August 17, 1990

The enclosed Removal Site Evaluation for the K-65 decant sump tank has been reviewed by my office. Based on this review, DOE, as the lead agency at the FMPC, has determined that a time-critical removal action is necessary to remove water from the K-65 decant sump tank, following the guidelines of the National Contingency Plan (NCP). An administrative record file should be established for this action.

The removal of the water in the decant sump tank should be completed prior to initiating the planned K-65 slant borings underneath the silos. A work plan for implementation of the removal action should be prepared and submitted to the DOE Site Office for approval on or before September 7, 1990.
