
Dear Mr. Reafsnyder:

On April 10, 1989, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) approved the "Implementation Plan for the K-65 and Metal Oxide Residue Sampling Project" for the United States Department of Energy's (U.S. DOE) Feed Materials Production Center in Fernald, Ohio. During a May 25, 1989 meeting, an amendment to the sampling plan was proposed by U.S. DOE and Westinghouse to increase the number of cores and sample material to be removed in order to support Feasibility Study (FS) work.
