Listed below are Ohio EPA's comments on the k-65 Decant Sump Tank Removal Work Plan.

- 1) The schedule (90 working days) to complete the work outlined seems excessive for what is basically pumping out a tank with off-the-shelf equipment. DOE should make an effort to reduce the time required to complete this work. The schedule should also be presented in calendar days.
- 2) How long will the decant sump water be stored in tanks in the Plant 2/3 area before treatment?
- 3) Are the five holding tanks in Plant 2/3 existing or new tanks? Describe the temporary dike around these tanks.
