The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) acknowledges the receipt of the revised Initial Screening of Alternatives (ISA) report for Operable Unit (OU) #4 on October 30, 1990. U.S. EPA approves this revision, without the Appendix A. Appendix A is the list of potential Applicable or Relevant and Appropriate Requirements (ARARs), including To Be Considered (TBC) requirements to be considered in the detailed screening of alternatives. As stated in U.S. EPA's October 18, 1990, letter, all potential ARARs must be considered in the alternative screening process and subsequent tasks for Operable Unit #4.
