The major deficiency in the August, 1990 version of the RI/Risk Assessment Report for O.U. 4 has not been addressed in the revised document received by Ohio EPA on November 7. The RI/Risk Assessment should be based on actual data and not on assumptions. The failure of DOE to collect K-65 residue samples and conduct borings around and under the silos must be addressed.

Ohio EPA acknowledges receiving DOE's letter dated December 6, 1990 suggesting possible remedial schedule modifications. Decisions on this and other project management issues will be coordinated with U.S. EPA and other Ohio EPA management.
