On October 12, 1990, a work plan was submitted to install a Stormwater Collection System around the perimeter of the waste pits (Operable Unit 1). Waste Pit Area Stormwater Run-off

Control Removal Action

Introduction

This Permit Information Summary for the Waste Pit Area Storm Water Run-off Control Removal Action is provided pursuant to requirements of the consent agreement under Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) Section 120 and 106(a). Specifically, Section XIII, subparagraph B identifies three items of information pertaining to permits which would otherwise be required in the absence of provisions of Section 121(e)(1) of CERCLA and the NCP. The information required includes:

1. Identification of each permit that would otherwise be required;
2. Identification of the standards, requirements, criteria, or limitations that would have had to have been met to obtain each such permit; and
3. Explanation of how the response action will meet the standards, requirements, criteria, or limitations identified in item 2 above.

The permits which would otherwise be required for this removal action include:

- a. A Wetland Permit from the Army Corp of Engineers.
- b. A Water Permit to Install from Ohio EPA.

The sections which follow provide the additional information required by items 2 and 3 under headings entitled "Criteria and Limitations" and "Response Action Compliance Plan", respectively, for each permit.
