PLACEMENT OF SURVEY STAKES INTO PIT FOUR

As was discussed with you on October 16, 1990, three survey stakes were driven into the Waste Pit four interim RCRA cap. These stakes were placed at the sites where waste pit samples will be collected after an amendment to the RCRA interim closure is obtained. The stakes were placed on October 6, 1990 and were removed on October 17, 1990. The stakes were placed between 3 to 6 inches into the pit cover and did not breach the entire cover. After the stakes were removed the Hypalon cover was patched.

The contractor tasked with conducting this work was attempting to meet a tight schedule for the collection of the waste pit samples and was not aware of the RCRA issue. My staff was not informed that this action was being initiated. This communication problem has been rectified.
