

OPERABLE UNIT 4 - RI/FS SCHEDULE

On November 6, 1990, DOE submitted a revised Remedial Investigation Report, which had previously been disapproved by U.S. EPA due to lack of site characterization data. On November 27, 1990, DOE, U.S. EPA and Ohio EPA initiated discussions concerning obtaining sampling data from Operable Unit 4 and continuation of the RI/FS process.

DOE has been attempting to obtain samples from the K-65 Silos for several years, and has been unsuccessful primarily because of circumstances beyond our control.

In order to complete the RI/FS process for this Operable Unit, there are several issues we would like to discuss. I would like to schedule a meeting on December 3, 1990, in Chicago, to continue these discussions and attempt to reach a mutually acceptable position regarding the successful continuation of the Operable Unit 4 RI/FS activities.
