Enclosed is the final report for the Comprehensive Ground Water Monitoring Evaluation (CME) that was conducted on April 9, 1990 at the U. S. Department of Energy, Feed Materials Production Center, 7400 Willey Road, Fernald, Hamilton County, Ohio.

The CME was conducted to determine the U. S. Department of Energy's compliance with the interim status standards for owners and operators of hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal facilities, specifically rules 3745-65-90 through 3745-65-94 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). The above noted regulations pertain to ground water monitoring. The CME was conducted by Mike Proffitt the Division of Ground Water, Southwest District Office, Ohio EPA.

The CME report consists of several sections including background information and data on site history and operation, various checklists and comments developed from these checklists. A review of the CME report revealed violations and deficiencies occurring at the facility which are explained in the Compliance Status Summary section on page 35 of the enclosed CME report.

Please respond to the above violations and deficiencies within thirty (30) days from the receipt of this letter. Your response should be submitted to me and Paul Pardi, Ohio EPA, Southwest District Office, Dayton, Ohio.
