**ROUND 5 RCRA GROUNDWATER MONITORING REPORT AND NOTIFICATION OF
STATISTICAL CHANGES IN INDICATOR PARAMETERS - FEED MATERIALS
PRODUCTION CENTER (FMPC)**

Enclosed is the final report summarizing the fifth round of Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) groundwater monitoring activities at the FMPC. As noted in Section 5.0 of the report, the statistical comparisons required by 40 CFR 265.93(b) were completed for the designated wells around Pit 4. These comparisons indicate that significant changes in various indicator parameters have occurred, thereby requiring that we notify you that Pit 4 may be affecting groundwater quality at the FMPC.

Within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter, the Department of Energy will provide you with a groundwater quality assessment plan for Pit 4, according to the requirements of 40 CFR 265.93(d). This plan will be based on the Groundwater Quality Assessment Program Outline, which was submitted to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as Item A.7 of the RCRA section for the Federal schedule of the groundwater assessment conducted as part of the current sitewide Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study at the FMPC.
