
As you know from various meetings and teleconferences, this treatability exercise should not be mistaken for the actual treatability Study for Operable Unit 4.

We anticipate that the results from these tests will provide input to the Treatability Study for Operable Unit 4, and should serve as a guide to ascertain the reliability of Operable Unit 4 Alternatives. I urge your early approval of this plan.
