Dear Mr. Avel:

On December 3, 1990, the United States Department of Energy (U.S. DOE) submitted a compendium of "document control requests" (DCR) for the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) work plan (including the QAPP). It is not clear what U.S. DOE's intentions are regarding this submittal. U.S. DOE has submitted some of these DCRs as proposed work plan addendums, but many have not been submitted and approved. U.S. DOE must comply with the approved work plan, along with the approved addendum.

U.S. DOE should specify which DCRs have been previously submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA), which were not previously submitted, and which are being currently submitted for U.S. EPA's review and approval. The approved work plan must be followed by U.S. DOE until any proposed changes are approved by U.S. EPA.

U.S. DOE should respond within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
