The United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) has completed its review of the revised Inactive Fly Ash Pile/Southfield Removal Action Work Plan. U.S. EPA hereby approves the Work Plan. However, given the high degree of soil contamination indicated by samples 24-081 and 24-241 the United States Department of Energy must take further action to evaluate and address the contaminated soils from these areas. U.S. EPA recommends this be accomplished by developing a second part of the removal action to address this issue.
