**REMOVAL ACTION MEMORANDUM: COLLECT UNCONTROLLED PRODUCTION AREA RUNOFF**

The enclosed Removal Site Evaluation for the proposed Collect Uncontrolled Production Area Runoff Removal Action (number 16) has been reviewed by my office. Based on this review and information from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) and Department of Energy (DOE) Consent Agreement renegotiations, DOE-Fernald Office (FO) has determined that this project constitutes a time critical removal action as defined in the National Contingency Plan.

It is recognized by the DOE-FO that it can capitalize upon an existing storm sewer improvements project, already under Title I/II design, to accomplish the goals of the required removal action. In accordance with the requirements and schedule set forth by the U.S. EPA and DOE Consent Agreement dated September 20, 1991, Westinghouse Environmental Management Project of Ohio (WEMCO) shall prepare and submit a removal action work plan for the subject project. The Administrative Record for the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) should include this decision document.

WEMCO and the DOE-FO should cooperatively work to complete the following tasks to implement this action:

1. Receive National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation approval and complete design of the storm sewer improvements project which will address the uncontrolled production area runoff removal action.
2. Establish a preferred methodology to implement the removal action and develop a draft work plan and schedule. Per the renegotiated Consent Agreement, the work plan is due to the U.S. EPA by March 2, 1992, for review and approval.
