Dear Mr. Craig:

On December 17, 1990, the United States Department of Energy (U.S. DOE) submitted a work plan for Removal Action #3 - Parts II and III, which is the South Groundwater Contaminant Plume - Part II Pumping and Discharge System and Part III Water Treatment System. On January 17, 1991, letter, U.S. EPA disapproved this draft work plan and identified deficiencies in the document. U.S. DOE submitted a revised work plan on March 14, 1991, U.S. DOE submitted a revised work plan and U.S. EPA has reviewed this revision.

Many of the same Quality Assurance Project Plan (QAPjP) issues identified in the work plan approval for removal #2 - waste pit stormwater control also apply to this work plan.

U.S. EPA is approving the revised work plan with the following modifications:

1. All samples must be analyzed in accordance with the approved QAPjP.
2. U.S. DOE may propose revisions to the QAPP to include additional laboratories, along with the latest laboratory audit and routine quality control analyses results. Documentation that the laboratory is capable of providing data of a quality equivalent to that required in the Remedial Investigation QAPjP must be presented.
