The U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) announces that the Administrative Record file for the Control Exposed Materials in Waste Pit 5 Removal Action is available for public review. The Administrative Record file will include documentation, as it is generated, relative to the decision for selecting and implementing the Control Exposed Materials in Waste Pit 5 Removal Action. These documents may include, but are not limited to, sampling data, comments, new data submitted by interested persons, and DOE responses to significant public comments.

The Control Exposed Materials in Waste Pit 5 Removal Action includes the control of airborne emissions from pit 5 due to the surface of exposed wastes that currently exists in the east end of the pit. Modifications to the pit, which will be done to allow redistribution of the exposed materials, and the placement of a water cover that will cover the entire surface of the pit, will control those particulate emissions that might be given off if the cover were not present.
