
The intent of this letter is to inform you that the action for removal of wastes identified in the scope for the Pit 5 Experimental Treatment Facility (ETF) Removal Action (RA) Number 11 was completed on March 20, 1992.

The project scope consisting of the removal of the facility structure, filter material, and waste was completed 22 days ahead of the scheduled completion date of April 11, 1992. The material was removed, containerized and transported to a designated on-site storage facility in accordance with the work plan. Current demobilization of equipment and demolition of the containment structure is occurring. At the completion of the sample analysis, a final Removal Action Report shall be developed and submitted.
