DISPOSAL OF SPECIFIC UNUSED CHEMICALS

Dispose of specific unused chemicals (see Attachment II for listing of chemicals) characterized as a RCRA waste. These chemicals are restricted wastes prohibited from land disposal under land disposal restriction rules.

PACKAGING OF THE WASTE

The wastes must be packaged in at least three separate containers to comply with DOT standards and CFR requirements. The wastes must be separated by hazard class and LDR requirements as follows:

1. sodium amide wastes
2. 2-ethoxy ethonal
3. all other wastes in an "Appendix V organic lab pack".

The lab pack must meet the requirements of 40 CFR 268.42(c). In addition, the lab pack must meet the DOT packaging requirements for lab packs specified under 49 CFR 173.12.

TRANSPORTATION

The supplier will provide licensed and insured transportation of the FEMP/DOE hazardous waste.

Truck/trailer must be in compliance with all regulations contained in the Code of Federal Regulations 49 CFR 171 through 177 and must meet the following requirements:

1. WEMCO shall have exclusive use of the vehicle. A dike must be present to contain spills.
2. The waste enclosure must be free of significant structural damage, including holes that would permit leakage into the trailer from outside or leakage from the trailer to the outside. WEMCO reserves the right to reject the trailer for significant defects at no cost.
3. Securing rear doors.
4. Tires should meet specifications set forth in 49 CFR 393.75.

DOCUMENTATION

Provide the proper state "Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest" (five copies) and the proper LDR notifications, and will assist in the preparation of the LDR notifications.

A copy of the signed manifest will be provided to WEMCO within 30 days from the shipment date.

The LDR notification must provide at least the following information (The attached chemical list provides the information required to complete the LDR notifications):

1. The EPA hazardous waste number.
2. The corresponding treatment standards, the subcategory (if any) of the waste, the treatability group of the waste, the CFR section and paragraph where the treatment standards appear, and the applicable 5-letter code where the treatment standard is expressed as a specific technology.
3. The manifest number associated with the waste shipment.
4. Any waste analysis data.
5. The vendor is to provide all required LDR certifications for signature by an authorized WEMCO representative.
6. A letter on company letterhead, stating the destination of the ash generated as a consequence of the incineration of this waste is at the Rollins RES(TX) facility only, shall be delivered to the WEMCO representative who witnesses the disposal.
7. Notifications must include identification of any California List prohibitions and associated prohibition levels as required in 268.32.

Traceability Documentation

Documentation shall be provided to WEMCO showing complete traceability and accountability of FEMP hazardous waste from Hazardous Waste Manifest through final disposal.

TREATMENT

All wastes will be treated as specified on the LDR notification. All treatments will be witnessed by a WEMCO representative.

DISPOSAL

Only RCRA licensed and authorized disposal facilities will be used for the final disposition of the wastes. Upon disposal, a Burn/Certificate of Disposal will be issued to WEMCO stating at a minimum the following:

1. Disposal or treatment method used.
2. Disposal dates per drum incinerated.

WITNESS REQUIREMENTS

All containers will be sealed prior to leaving the FEMP, and WEMCO personnel shall witness the opening of each of the containers for inner container verification and/or incineration, and shall witness the incineration operations.

Dispose of specific unused chemicals (see Attachment I for listing of chemicals) characterized as a RCRA waste. These chemicals are restricted wastes prohibited from land disposal under land disposal restriction rules.

WARRANTY - Customer

Customer represents and warrants that the Waste loaded and removed under this Agreement shall be the Waste defined by the Customer as a part of the contracting procedure, and the Waste has been thoroughly characterized on the Uniform Waste Data Sheet submitted to RES. Customer agrees to prepare and execute the RES Uniform Waste Data Sheet for each new waste stream. Customer shall resubmit any Uniform Waste Data Sheet as required by Federal, State or local law or regulation. Such Uniform Waste Data Sheets shall be deemed to be a part of this Agreement. If the Waste is packaged, Customer warrants that such Waste shall be prepared for shipment and packaged in containers specified by the then current and applicable regulations of the DOT, EPA or any successors thereto and/or any state municipal and/or Federal agency having jurisdiction, as the case may be.

ROLLINS Environmental Services (RES) REJECTION

Customer understands and agrees that RES, upon notice to Customer, has the absolute and unqualified right to reject any shipment of Waste which does not conform to the description on the Uniform Waste Data Sheet supplied by Customer to RES or if such waste does not meet RES's permit requirements. After any such rejection, RES will, with Customer's assistance and approval, pursue all other reasonable means of disposal. If the Waste is rejected, Customer shall be obligated: (1) to pay the cost of transportation to RES's facility if such transportation was performed by RES; (2) to pay the cost of return transportation from RES's facility to Customer's premises (Customer having the right to select the carrier); and (3) to pay all other reasonable charges incurred by RES, for hauling, loading, preparing, storing and caring for the Waste which has been rejected, including necessary analytical work, decontamination and cleaning of equipment. Dispose of specific unused chemicals (see Attachment I for listing of chemicals) characterized as a RCRA waste. These chemicals are restricted wastes prohibited from land disposal under land disposal restriction rules.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The following Westinghouse General Provisions do not apply to this Purchase Order:

1. Section A.6(D)--Delivery and Payment.
2. Section A.13(B)--Work on WEMCO, Government, or other premises.
3. Section D.9(A)--Audit-Examination of Costs.

Section A.28--Worker's Compensation Coverage and Indemnity is modified as follows: add to the end of the section "except to the extent of the negligence or breach of warranty by the Government and/or WEMCO."
