GENERAL COMMENTS

1. It is not clear why the number of samples (18) analyzed for post action period was greater than the number analyzed (six) for pre-action and action periods.
2. On page 4, 1,1,2,2-tetrachloroethane and total particulates are listed as hazards that will be monitored during the removal action. However, there are no data for these parameters in the report. This data, or the reason for its omission, should be provided in the report.
