**SECURITY AT RI/FS OFFSITE MONITORING WELLS**

In the May 17, 1988 Technical Information Exchange Meeting, the USEPA requested that the DOE address the plans in place to assure the integrity of the offsite wells. A series of control measures are currently being implemented by WMCO on the Groundwater Monitoring Program of the RI/FS to assure the continued integrity of the offsite wells.

As specified in the RI/FS Work Plan Revision 3, all offsite wells are being equipped with protective outer casings with locking caps. A rubber gasket is being installed on the locking caps to reduce the potential for the cross contamination. Inside each protective casing, the void space outside the well riser is being filled with an absorbent material. The absorbent is be added to help prevent foreign liquids from reaching the well casing. Finally, a crimp seal is being installed on each locking cap to identify if tampering has occurred at the well location.
