
TRANSMITTAL OF CLOSURE PLAN INFORMATION AND DATA FOR THE WASTE OIL STORAGE IN GARAGE

Enclosed is a copy of the Closure Plan Information and Data for the Waste Oil Storage in Garage Hazardous Waste Management Unit (HWMU) at the Department of Energy, Fernald Field Office (DOE-FN) Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP), in Fernald, Ohio. This document is submitted to fulfill the requirements of Section II of the Proposed Amended Consent Decree (PACD) between the State of Ohio and DOE, et. al. (CIVIL NO. C-1-86-0217). In Section II paragraph 3.12 of the PACD, DOE is required to submit a schedule that identifies projected activities for newly identified HWMUs. The schedule, which sets forth timetables for the submittal of closure plans, was submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) on August 27, 1991. This Closure Plan Information and Data for the Waste Oil Storage in Garage satisfies one of the commitments in the schedule for submittal of a closure plan to close the unit.

This closure plan information and data provides for clean closure under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), and does not expect remedial response activities will be required for the unit. In the event that soil sampling detects contamination from RCRA hazardous waste constituents, revised closure plan information and data, along with a revised schedule, will be submitted to the OEPA. Any remediation required at the unit will be integrated with response or remedial activities scheduled under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) at the FEMP site. Ohio EPA approval of the enclosed document is requested.
