Dear Mr. Craig:

On July 29, 1992, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) disapproved the Operable Unit (OU) #3 Remedial Investigation (RI) and Feasibility Study (FS) Work Plan Addendum. Due to U.S. EPA's extensive comments, several meetings were held between U.S. EPA, the United States Department of Energy (U.S. DOE), and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA). All parties agreed that before a date for submittal of a revised Work Plan could be determined, U.S. DOE must first submit an approach for revising the OU #3 Work Plan Addendum.

On September 14, 1992, U.S. DOE submitted the revised Work Plan approach to U.S. EPA. On October 8, 1992, a meeting was held between U.S. DOE, U.S. EPA, and OEPA to discuss the revised approach. At the conclusion of the meeting all parties agreed upon the approach for revising the work Plan.

Therefore, U.S. DOE must submit a revised OU #3 Work Plan Addendum, to U.S. EPA for review and approval, within sixty (60) days of receipt of this letter.
