Dear Mr. Craig:

The purpose of this letter is to conditionally approve the Improved Soil and Debris Removal Action Work Plan (#17). The conditions for approval are that DOE conduct the removal action in accordance with the conditions listed below:

1. Contaminated soil and/or debris which is known to be hazardous waste must be either containerized or placed in a containment structure.
2. If the quantity of hazardous waste soil and/or debris is large enough to require management controls other than those specified in the above condition, DOE FEMP must contact Ohio EPA, Division of Hazardous Waste Management, for concurrence in regard to temporary control measures utilized to manage the waste.
