This letter is written in response to your November 22, 1992 letter and the attached "Compliance Schedule for the Remaining Drums Identified Under the Proposed Amended Consent Decree at the FEMP". The following comments are offered regarding the compliance schedules.

1. Provide justification for the June 30, 1993 date for compliance with OAC 3745-66-71 through OAC 3745-66-73. Provide information regarding the number of drums currently out of compliance with each of these regulations, along with an explanation of the nature and extent of non-compliance.
2. The compliance date of June 30, 1993 for OAC 3745-65-17 (and 54-17) implies that non-compliance with these regulations exists. If this is the case, provide information regarding the nature and extent of this non-compliance. Include the specific number of containers holding incompatible waste streams, the waste codes and waste streams involved, and provide a justification for the June 30, 1993 compliance date.

All other compliance dates are acceptable. Please respond in writing within 30 days of the date of this letter with the information requested above.
