UPCOMING SUBMITTAL OF REVISED RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT PART A PERMIT APPLICATION

- Reference: 1) DOE-2813-92, W. D. Adams to P. Pardi, "Proposed Amended Consent Decree Compliance Schedule Requirements for the Remaining Drums Identified Under the Proposed Amended Consent Decree," dated November 24, 1992
- 2) FD-92-463, J. A. Rasile to D. R. Schregardus (OEPA), "Information Regarding Administrative Change of Co-Operator for the Fernald Environmental Management Project," dated November 30, 1992

In accordance with the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-50-51 the Fernald Environmental Restoration Management Corporation (FERMCO) notified the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) of its intent to act as co-operator of the Fernald Environmental Management Project (FEMP) effective December 1, 1992 (Reference 2). Also, in the same communication, it was noted that the necessary revisions to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Part A Permit Application to reflect the change in co-operator status would be submitted by January 4, 1993.


However, based on the conversation between Ed Skintik, Beth Osheim, and Paul Pardi on January 13, 1993, it was determined that the OEPA would prefer to have the entire Part A Permit Application submitted instead of only the revised pages reflecting the co-operator change.

There have been changes/additions to the hazardous waste streams since the last revision to the FEMP's Part A Permit Application. In order to submit an entire RCRA Part A Permit Application, other updates must be made at this time to submit an accurate and entire Part A Permit Application.

The forthcoming revised RCRA Part A Permit Application will include additional waste streams as required by the compliance schedules (Reference 1) for the remaining 20 percent of the 26,000 drums not affected by the Hazardous Waste Management Unit Review. No new hazardous waste management units have been identified since the last Part A Permit Application submittal. Item X, Other Environmental Permits, will be updated to include the latest permits. In addition to the updated waste stream information, the new certification/signature pages reflecting the change in co-operator for the site will be submitted. The revised application will be submitted to OEPA by March 1, 1993.
