Four additional liner seam separations were identified during the Removal Action No. 18 field activities, and will be repaired to the degree possible in the spring of 1993. These four additional liner separations will be patched and sealed in accordance with the repair procedures set forth in the Waste Pit 5 Liner Repair Work Plan.
