
**REMOVAL ACTION MEMORANDUM: TEMPORARY NITRATE STORAGE TANKS**

The enclosed Removal Site Evaluation for the Temporary Nitrate Storage Tanks has been reviewed by my office. Based on this review and the terms of the 1991 Amended Consent Agreement, the Department of Energy has determined, from its authority under Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation & Liability Act Section 104, a Removal Action is not warranted. The Administrative Record file for the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) should include this document.

The potential threat of the temporary nitrate tanks does not warrant a Removal Action. The existing monitoring and water level control procedures for the tanks are adequate. The restoration of this area will be addressed through the RI/FS process and subsequently during Remedial Design/Remedial Action.
