ACTION MEMORANDUM FOR THE KC-2 WAREHOUSE/WELL #67

The Removal Site Evaluation (RSE) for the KC-2 Warehouse/Well #67 has been reviewed by my office. Based on this review, the Department of Energy (DOE) has determined that this project currently constitutes a time-critical Removal Action as defined in the National Contingency Plan. This letter constitutes the Action Memorandum which identifies lead agency concurrence that the subject work has been identified as a time critical removal action. The Administrative Record for the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) Study should include this document. Fernald Environmental Restoration Management Corporation (FERMCO) and the DOE Site Office should work cooperatively to complete the following tasks to implement this removal action:

1. Removal of the sediment currently in the well casing.
2. Determination of groundwater quality after removal of sediment from well casing.
3. Plug and abandon Well #67.
4. Determine the need for further groundwater investigations.

Department of Energy, Fernald Field Office (DOE-FN) requests that FERMCO submit a Removal Action Work Plan with contingencies by May 13, 1993, which will provide a detailed schedule for completion of items 1-4 listed above.
