Dear Mr. Rowland:

This letter is written in response to your May 12, 1993 letter in which you propose an alternate groundwater monitoring program as allowed through OAC 3745-65-90(D). The proposal describes the use of the CERCLA groundwater investigative process currently proposed in the Operable Unit 5 Work Plan and its addenda.

The Ohio EPA is currently reviewing your proposal, but is not prepared to offer a conclusive response at this time. Your letter indicates that monitor wells are scheduled to be installed beginning in June so that the Subpart F groundwater monitoring system will be in place by the October 1, 1993 date promised in the current FEMP Groundwater Monitoring Plan (GMP). These wells will not need to be installed if the Ohio EPA accepts your alternate program.

In order for FEMP to delay installation of these wells until a definitive response from our agency is offered, through this letter I am granting an extension of 60 days to the October 1, 1993 deadline for completing the Subpart F monitoring system.
